(glass is 35 x 12 inch)



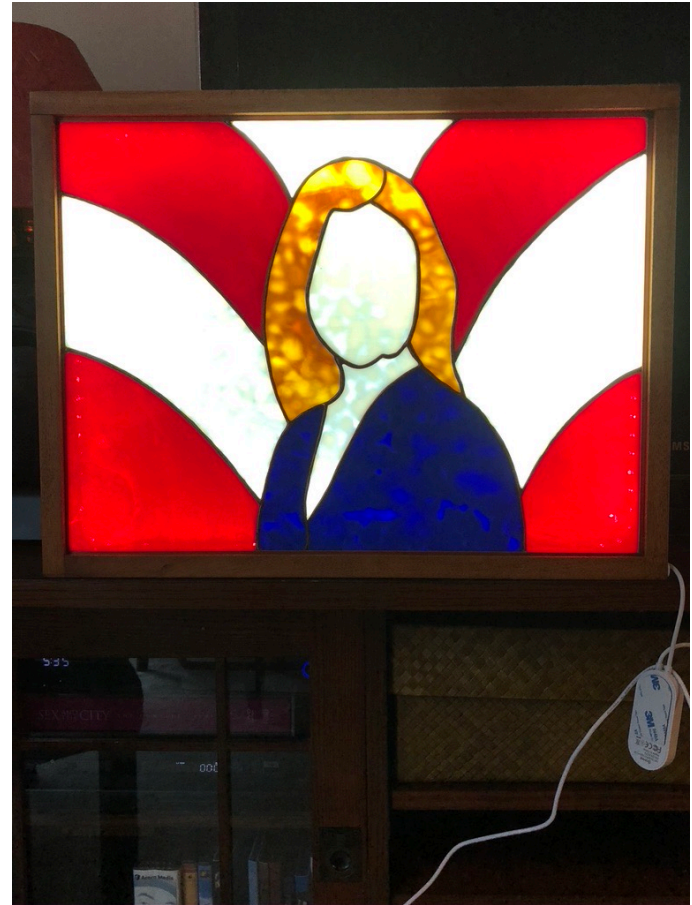


Hanging from short chains screwed into the interior window frame to create privacy in this street-level window
