



Hanging from brackets screwed into ceiling (glass is 35 x 12 inch)






Hanging from short chains screwed into the interior window frame to create privacy in this street-level window

(each piece is 21 x 33 inch)


Hanging from short chains screwed into the side window frame to create privacy in this bathroom (glass is 33 x 21 inch)
